These juried fine art/fine craft fairs are held outdoors on the Figge Art Museum Plaza and on 2nd Street in downtown Davenport, Iowa rain or shine.

The Beaux Arts Fund Committee, a non-profit group of volunteers, donates proceeds to the Figge Art Museum to help fund exhibitions and educational programs. No commissions will be charged. The fairs are free to the public.

Please Note Deadline Dates

This will be the only application mailed for both fairs.

2012 Calendar

- Feb 15 - Postmarked Deadline for Spring Fair or Combined Spring/Fall Application
- Mar 15 - Notification mailed for Spring Fair and Spring Fair checks cashed
- May 30 - Postmarked Deadline for Fall Fair (if not combined earlier with Spring application)
- June 30 - Notification mailed for Fall Fair and Fall Fair checks cashed

How to Enter:

Jury Process:

Please submit three slides or CD (jpeg. format) of work done in the last 3 years, and one of booth. Label each slide or face of CD clearly with artist's name. Label each image/slide with applicable number 1-4, title, & size of work to coordinate with application. Artist's name or person should not appear within images on slides, jpegs or jpeg labels. Slides should be in plastic sleeves. No photos please.

Images submitted for jury should be an accurate representation of art to be displayed at fair. Process for making artwork must be fully explained on application. This will be read to jury along with title, size and price. Make sure it is legible. No other information will be read, ie. awards, etc. The Committee has the right to request the removal of any art not represented in the jury images or any undesirable items.

Each artist is required to submit a non-refundable \$10.00 jury fee. Separate checks are required for jury fee, booth fee and corner fee. Completed application and all checks must be received in advance of the jurying process. If not accepted, all checks will be returned except the non-refundable jury fee.

Save \$10.00

Applicants applying for both fairs at the same time only need to pay one jury fee. Also, only one set of slides or images need to be submitted if you apply for both fairs in the Spring. This means that your images/slides will be held over for the Fall Fair jury. Acceptance or rejection to the Spring Fair does not affect acceptance or rejection to the Fall Fair. Each fair will be juried separately. All checks and both spring & fall completed applications must be submitted for both fairs by Feb. 15 to qualify. Booth and corner checks will not be cashed until their respective notification dates.

Security:

Security will be provided beginning at 5:00 pm Friday evening through Sunday, however, damage or loss will be the responsibility of the artist and not the Fair Committee. Police and EMS will be present throughout the entire event.

Cancellation Policy:

All cancellations must be made in writing, signed by the artist, and post-marked on or before March 15, 2012 for Spring fair or June 30, 2012 for Fall fair. Any accepted artist who cancels and meets above requirements will be entitled to a refund. Absolutely no refunds will be made for cancellations postmarked after March 15 (Spring fair) or June 30 (Fall fair).

Rules:

- All Artists & Craftsmen over the age of 18, professional or amateur are invited to exhibit and sell their work.
- All work must be of original design and handcrafted by the exhibiting artist. One medium/one artist per booth/no shared booths. Artist must be present during fair hours.
- All exhibitors must provide their own display, tables, chairs, and white canopy. All storage must be contained and concealed within booth area.

NO staking or drilling permitted.

- All booths will be on paving brick or pavement. Structures should be built to withstand gusty wind. Minimum weights of 50-80 lbs per leg are recommended. Any artist with a hazardous display will be required to close and will forfeit their registration fee.

No gas powered generators allowed.

- Exhibitors are required to collect and submit IA state sales tax. Temporary tax forms will be available.
- Booth must remain open during fair hours.

Set-Up:

PLAZA: Setup times will be assigned for the plaza area beginning at noon on Friday. Detailed instructions will be mailed with acceptance letter. Arriving during your set up time will assure you the most convenient access to your booth. Please note that the plaza has a slope of 3" in 10'.

STREET: You may start setting up after 3 pm on Friday.

Vehicles must be out of the Fair area by 9am on Fair day, no exceptions!

Teardown:

COME PREPARED TO CART! Teardown is not permitted until close of art fair! NO vehicles will be allowed on fair grounds until Security deems that it is safe to do so! NO EXCEPTIONS! Failure to abide will result in future non-participation. **PLAZA:** Vehicles will not be allowed into Plaza area for load out and will be parked at the curb in front of the Plaza until booths are removed from the parking area, at which time vehicles will be allowed to pull in. Teardown instructions will be included in your packet at check-in. **COME PREPARED TO CART!**
